
I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Air transport industry in Bulgaria was represented by 49 companies at the end of 2016, compared to 46 in the previous year and 48 in 2014.
- The industry's net loss amounted to BGN 17,267,000 in 2016.
- The industry's total revenue was BGN 774,525,000 in 2016, down by 8.20% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Air transport industry reached BGN 788,200,000 in 2016, down by 5.44% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.84% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016, compared to 0.94% for 2015 and 1.00% in 2014.
- A total of 2,012 people were employed in the Air transport industry in 2016, compared to 1,892 in 2015 and 1,854 in 2014.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Sofia, followed by Varna and Plovdiv.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2016 the companies in the Air transport industry numbered 49, distributed in 2 sectors.






In 2015 there were a total of 46 companies operating in the industry. In 2014 their number totalled 48.

III. REVENUES


The total revenue in the industry was BGN 774,525,000 in 2016, BGN 843,691,000 in 2015 and 857,732,000 in 2014.



The companies in the Air transport market of Bulgaria earned combined net sales revenues of BGN 724,538,000 in 2016.

In annual terms, sales marked a decline of 3.67% compared to 2015. In comparison to 2014 they decreased by 2.07%. In 2015 sales fell by 1.66% year-on-year.

The Air transport industry total revenue make up 0.84% to the country's GDP in 2016, compared to 0.94% for 2015 and 1.00% in 2014.



In 2016 the Air transport industry contributed to GDP BGN 717,306,000 in Gross value added (GVA) accounting for 0.47% of the total for the country's economy.


In the previous year, the industry's GVA amounted BGN 772,662,000, accounting for 0.50% of the total for the country in 2015. In 2014 the GVA of the Air transport was BGN 754,231,000, or 0.53% of the GVA for the country's economy.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Air transport industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -4.97% in 2017.

Passenger air transport contributed net sales revenue of BGN 636,902,000 or 87.90% of the total net sales in the industry, and sector Freight air transport - BGN 87,636,000 (12.10%).



There was no industry's sector to report a growth in net sales revenues. In terms of annual drop, the top position was occupied by Freight air transport with 12.61%.



The 10 largest companies in terms of total revenue in sector Freight air transport earned total revenue of BGN 94,922,000 and accounted for 12.26% of the industry's total revenue.

IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Air transport industry reached BGN 788,200,000 in 2016.




In annual terms, total expenses went down by 5.44% compared to 2015 and went down by 11.42% in comparison to 2014.

The total operating expenses of the companies in the Air transport industry were BGN 750,895,000 in 2016.

Operating costs fell by 3.20% compared with the previous year and fell by 9.46% when compared to 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Air transport industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -5.88% in 2017.

Passenger air transport reported the highest total costs, of BGN 701,055,000, followed by Freight air transport with BGN 87,145,000.




There was no industry's sector to report a increase in total costs. In terms of annual fall, the top position was occupied by Freight air transport with 11.25%.

There was no industry's sector to report a increase in operating costs. In terms of annual fall, the top position was occupied by Freight air transport with 7.43%.

The biggest spenders in the industry, with costs of over 10% of industry's costs, numbered 5, including BALGARIAN EAR CHARTAR OOD, BRIN EOOD, BULGARIA AIR AD, B H AIR OOD, CARGO AIR OOD. The medium spenders, or those in the 5% and 10% range count 1 and include HELI AIR SERVICES AD. Below 5% threshhold are 43 companies, including OLIMPIK EAR - KLON BULGARIA KTCH, JET OPS EUROPE OOD, SANLAYT EAR EAD, VICTORIA AIR OOD, VENID EAR EOOD.

Employment expenses in the Air transport industry went up by 15.78% on the year to BGN 79,046,000 in 2016.



The highest growth in labour costs, of 32.39%, was registered by Freight air transport.

The monthly costs per employee in the Air transport industry averaged BGN 3,274 in 2016, BGN 3,007 in 2015 and BGN 2,753 in 2014.

The monthly social security costs per employee in the industry averaged BGN 446 in 2016, versus BGN 426 in 2015 and BGN 387 in 2014.





V. PROFITABILITY

The industry's net loss amounted to BGN 17,267,000 in 2016, compared to a net profit of BGN 6,708,000 in 2015 and a net loss of BGN 34,201,000 in 2014.


The profit margin for the Air transport industry stood at -1.82% in 2016, while in 2015 it amounted to 1.26% and -4.25% in 2014.





About 80.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in SOFIA, while 10.00% are BREZNIK-based and 10.00% are headquartered in PLOVDIV.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Air transport industry amounted to BGN 360,108 in 2016, down by 9.41% compared to 2015 and down by 9.76% compared to 2014.

The industry's average operating revenue per employee fell by 11.72% year-on-year in 2016 to BGN 373,051. It fell by 13.76% compared to 2014.

The Air transport industry generated an average BGN 384,953 in total revenue per employee. In 2015 and 2014 the figure was BGN 445,925 and BGN 462,639, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Air transport industry dropped to BGN 15,806,633 in 2016 from BGN 18,341,109 in 2015. The 2014 value was BGN 17,869,417.

A company in the Air transport field made on average a net sales revenue of BGN 14,786,490 in 2016, compared to BGN 16,350,652 in 2015 and BGN 15,414,250 in 2014.

The Air transport industry made 0.29% of the overall sales country-wide, reducing its market share by 0.01 pp.

Operating profit per employee for the industry as a whole was BGN -6,797 in 2016. For comparison in 2015 it amounted to BGN 5,337 and BGN 5,337 in 2014.

Debt-to-assets ratio of the companies in the industry is 0.78 in 2016. It was 0.70 in 2015 and 0.91 in 2014.

According to market experts, the greatest impact on the development of the Air transport industry has net sales revenue from services. In 2016 it stood at BGN 719,267,000, according to the financial statements of the companies in the industry. In 2015 the figure was BGN 746,753,000 and BGN 734,052,000 in 2014.



NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES BY INDUSTRY SECTORS



The Air transport's share in the country's total employment was 0.09% in 2016, 0.10% in 2015 and 0.10% in 2014.
