


### I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Air transport industry in Bulgaria was represented by 56 companies at the end of 2018, compared to 50 in the previous year and 49 in 2016.
- The industry's net profit amounted to BGN 9,280,000 in 2018.
- The industry's total revenue was BGN 848,636,000 in 2018, down by 0.54% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Air transport industry reached BGN 835,357,000 in 2018, down by 5.01% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.86% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2018, compared to 0.89% for 2017 and 0.84% in 2016.
- A total of 2,205 people were employed in the Air transport industry in 2018, compared to 2,010 in 2017 and 2,012 in 2016.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Sofia, followed by Plovdiv and Nesebar.

## II. INTRODUCTION

In 2018 the companies in the Air transport industry numbered 56, distributed in 2 sectors.






In 2017 there were a total of 50 companies operating in the industry. In 2016 their number totalled 49.

## III. REVENUES


The total revenue in the industry was BGN 848,636,000 in 2018, BGN 853,201,000 in 2017 and 774,525,000 in 2016.



The companies in the Air transport market of Bulgaria earned combined net sales revenues of BGN 786.109,000 in 2018.

In annual terms, sales marked an increase of 3.06% compared to 2017. In comparison to 2016 they grew by 8.50%. In 2017 sales went up by 5.28% year-on-year.

The Air transport industry total revenue make up 0.86% to the country's GDP in 2018, compared to 0.89% for 2017 and 0.84% in 2016.



In 2018 the Air transport industry contributed to GDP BGN 786,167,000 in Gross value added (GVA) accounting for 0.43% of the total for the country's economy.

In the previous year, the industry's GVA amounted BGN 704,274,000, accounting for 0.41% of the total for the country in 2017. In 2016 the GVA of the Air transport was BGN 717,306,000, or 0.47% of the GVA for the country's economy.



We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Air transport industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 4.68% in 2019.

Passenger air transport contributed net sales revenue of BGN 672,751,000 or 85.58% of the total net sales in the industry, and sector Freight air transport - BGN 113,358,000 (14.42%).





The highest growth, of 13.97%, was recorded by Freight air transport. There was no industry's sector to report a drop in net sales revenues.

2017 and 0.80% in 2016.



The 10 largest companies in terms of total revenue in sector Passenger air transport earned total revenue of BGN 696,620,000 and accounted for 82.09% of the industry's total revenue.

## IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Air transport industry reached BGN 835,357,000 in 2018.




In annual terms, total expenses went down by 5.01% compared to 2017 and went up by 5.98% in comparison to 2016.

The total operating expenses of the companies in the Air transport industry were BGN 808,459,000 in 2018.

Operating costs decreased by 3.19% compared with the previous year and grew by 7.67% when compared to 2016.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Air transport industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 2.95% in 2019.

Passenger air transport reported the highest total costs, of BGN 730,917,000, followed by Freight air transport with BGN 104.440.000.




Freight air transport marked the highest annual growth in total expenses, of 3.16%, while total expenses dropped the most, by 6.07%, for Passenger air transport.

In terms of operating expenses, the highest growth, of 9.55%, was recorded by the Freight air transport sector. The sharpest drop was posted by Passenger air transport - 4.78%.

The biggest spenders in the industry, with costs of over 10% of industry's costs, numbered 5, including BUL AIR EOOD, CARGO AIR OOD, BULGARIA AIR AD, B H AIR OOD, BULGARIAN AIR CHARTER EAD. The medium spenders, or those in the 5% and 10% range count 3 and include WIZZ AIR HUNGARY BRANCH BULGARIA, HELI AIR SERVICES AD, BULGARIAN EAGLE EOOD. Below 5% threshhold are 48 companies, including D I D KARGO OOD, ALEKSANDROV EAR EOOD, TAYARAN JET EAD, INTERSKY AD, OLIMPIK EAR - KLON BULGARIA KCHT.

Employment expenses in the Air transport industry went up by 17.32% on the year to BGN 100,155,000 in 2018.



The highest growth in labour costs, of 18.53%, was registered by Freight air transport.

The monthly costs per employee in the Air transport industry averaged BGN 3,785 in 2018, BGN 3,539 in 2017 and BGN 3,274 in 2016.

The monthly social security costs per employee in the industry averaged BGN 507 in 2018, versus BGN 458 in 2017 and BGN 446 in 2016.





## V. PROFITABILITY

The industry's net profit amounted to BGN 9,280,000 in 2018, compared to a net loss of BGN 24,889,000 in 2017 and a net loss of BGN 17,267,000 in 2016.


The profit margin for the Air transport industry stood at 1.60% in 2018, while in 2017 it amounted to -3.18% and -1.82% in 2016.





The Air transport industry's return on equity (ROE) is 3.90% compared to -11.19% in 2017 and -11.42% in 2016.

The Air transport's return on assets (ROA) was 1.27%, while in 2017 it amounted to -3.58% and -2.39% in 2016.

About 90.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in SOFIA, while 10.00% are STAROSEL-based.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Air transport industry amounted to BGN 356,512 in 2018, down by 6.05% compared to 2017 and down by 1.00% compared to 2016.

The industry's average operating revenue per employee went down by 8.05% year-on-year in 2018 to BGN 376,826. It increased by 1.01% compared to 2016.

The Air transport field generated an average BGN 384,869 in total revenue per employee. In 2017 and 2016 the figure was BGN 424,478 and BGN 384,953, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Air transport industry went down to BGN 15,154,214 in 2018 from BGN 17,064,020 in 2017. The 2016 value was BGN 15,806,633.

A company in the Air transport industry made on average a net sales revenue of BGN 14,037,661 in 2018, compared to BGN 15,255,180 in 2017 and BGN 14,786,490 in 2016.

The Air transport industry made 0.27% of the overall sales country-wide, reducing its market share by 0.01 pp.

Operating profit per employee for the industry as a whole was BGN 6,022 in 2018. For comparison in 2017 it amounted to BGN -13,028 and BGN -13,028 in 2016.

Debt-to-assets ratio of the companies in the industry is 0.67 in 2018. It was 0.67 in 2017 and 0.78 in 2016.

According to market experts, the greatest impact on the development of the Air transport industry has net sales revenue from services. In 2018 it stood at BGN 780,177,000, according to the financial statements of the companies in the industry. In 2017 the figure was BGN 692,253,000 and BGN 719,267,000 in 2016.




