


I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Telecommunications industry in Romania was represented by 2,445 companies at the end of 2016, compared to 2,453 in the previous year and 2,330 in 2014.
- The industry's net profit amounted to RON 226,724,551 in 2016.
- The industry's total revenue was RON 20,083,286,958 in 2016, down by 9.26% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Telecommunications industry reached RON 19,725,265,463 in 2016, down by 10.23% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 2.16% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016, compared to 2.57% for 2015 and 1.75% in 2014.
- A total of 34,740 people were employed in the Telecommunications industry in 2016, compared to 40,535 in 2015 and 32,929 in 2014.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Bucharest, followed by lasi and Cluj.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2016 the companies in the Telecommunications industry numbered 2,445, distributed in 4 sectors.






In 2015 there were a total of 2,453 companies operating in the industry. In 2014 their number totalled 2,330.

III. REVENUES

The total revenue in the industry was RON 20,083,286,958 in 2016, RON 22,133,898,167 in 2015 and 14,285,708,595 in 2014.




The companies in the Telecommunications market of Romania earned combined net sales revenues of RON 18,382,198,081 in 2016.

In annual terms, sales marked a decline of 7.65% compared to 2015. In comparison to 2014 they went up by 41.92%. In 2015 sales rose by 53.68% year-on-year.

The Telecommunications industry total revenue make up 2.16% to the country's GDP in 2016, compared to 2.57% for 2015 and 1.75% in 2014.




We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Telecommunications industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 18.57% in 2017.

IV. EXPENSES


The combined costs of the companies in the Telecommunications industry reached RON 19,725,265,463 in 2016.

In annual terms, total expenses decreased by 10.23% compared to 2015 and rose by 40.64% in comparison to 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Telecommunications industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 18.59% in 2017.

Other telecommunications activities marked the highest annual growth in total expenses, of 17.58%, while total expenses went down the most, by 27.07%, for Wired telecommunications activities.

The biggest spenders in the industry, with costs of over 10% of industry's costs, numbered 5, including ORANGE ROMANIA SA, VODAFONE ROMANIA SA, UPC ROMANIA SRL, RCS & RDS SA, TELEKOM ROMANIA MOBILE COMMUNICATIONS SA (FORMERLY KNOWN AS COSMOTE ROMANIAN MOBILE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SA). The medium spenders, or those in the 5% and 10% range count 3 and include DIGITAL CABLE SYSTEMS SA, VOX CARRIER SRL, SOCIETATEA NATIONALA DE RADIOCOMUNICATII SA. Below 5% threshhold are 2,437 companies, including TEVECOM SRL, BEIA TELECOM SRL, ATTP TELECOMMUNICATIONS SRL, SIV'TEL SERVICE SRL, ALTAIR NET SRL.

Employment expenses in the Telecommunications industry went down by 21.69% on the year to RON 2,044,090,895 in 2016.

The highest growth in labour costs, of 13.60%, was registered by Other telecommunications activities, while Wired telecommunications activities marked the sharpest fall, of 30.41%.

The monthly costs per employee in the Telecommunications industry averaged RON 4,903 in 2016, RON 5,366 in 2015 and RON 4,461 in 2014.





The Telecommunications's return on assets (ROA) was 0.94%, while in 2015 it amounted to -0.16% and 0.41% in 2014.

About 70.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in Bucharest, while 10.00% are lasi-based and 10.00% are headquartered in Arges.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Telecommunications industry amounted to RON 529,136 in 2016, up by 7.75% compared to 2015 and up by 34.52% compared to 2014.

The Telecommunications field generated an average RON 578,103 in total revenue per employee. In 2015 and 2014 the figure was RON 546,044 and RON 433,834, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Telecommunications industry dropped to RON 8,214,023 in 2016 from RON 9,023,195 in 2015. The 2014 value was RON 6,131,205.

A company in the Telecommunications sector made on average a net sales revenue of RON 7,518,281 in 2016, compared to RON 8,114,528 in 2015 and RON 5,559,057 in 2014.

The Telecommunications industry made 1.54% of the overall sales country-wide, reducing its market share by 0.19 pp.




